Pauli v. Various Insurers,

The Supreme Court of Canada has refused leave to Pauli concerning his application to seek leave to appeal the decision of the Court of Appeal of Alberta which had dismissed an appeal from the Court of Queen's Bench. Pauli had brought proceedings on behalf of a class of insureds that were charged a deductible in a situation where their vehicles had sustained a total loss and the insurer took benefit of the salvage. The Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta had denied Pauli's claim for the return of his deductible. This now appears to be the final chapter on this issue in Alberta. Finally a win for insurers in the SCC!
